

Dr. Cesar Casado is a plastic surgeon based in Madrid (Spain), specialist at La Paz University Hospital and head of the Plastic Surgery Department at Ruber Internacional Hospital.

He is President of the Spanish Association of Microsurgery, former General Secretary of the Spanish Society of Plastic, Reconstructive and Aesthetic Surgery and Professor in the Department of Surgery at the Faculty of Medicine of the Autonomous University of Madrid,
