

**Dr. Halle**, President of the **Swedish Society for Reconstructive Microsurgery (SFRM)** is Associate Professor of Plastic Surgery at **Karolinska Institutet**, and Senior Consultant at **Karolinska University Hospital**, where he has served as Director of Microsurgery. Dr. Halle is internationally recognized for his expertise in complex cancer reconstruction, with a career dedicated to advancing surgical outcomes for patients undergoing breast, head, and neck reconstruction—particularly those affected by radiotherapy. At this year's Congress, Dr. Halle will be presenting on **Breast Reconstruction focused on Conversion from Implant to Autologous Tissue in the Irradiated Breast**. This lecture addresses one of the most challenging scenarios in reconstructive breast surgery. Indications, technical considerations, and aesthetic outcome improvements will be discussed. In addition he will talk about **Raising the Aesthetic Bar for Head and Neck Cancer Patients**. With an expertise in both head and neck reconstruction and aesthetic surgery of the face and neck, Dr. Halle will explore how advanced techniques can achieve not only functional restoration but also meaningful aesthetic refinement. His talk emphasizes the importance of quality of life, holistic patient outcomes, and the evolving role of reconstructive artistry in oncologic care.
